

Reflective log

To be successful for credentialing, you have to write 3 reflective logs. The cases should reflect on your professional practice while providing care throughout the perianaesthetic continuum and should clearly demonstrate the application of theory to practice, decision-making and problem solving.

Reflective log

1. Record: describe the situation (the context), who was involved and what did they have to do with the situation (max 100 words).

2. Reflect: think about what are your reactions, what are your feelings, what are the good and the bad aspects of the situation, what you have learned (max 100 words).

3. Analyse, explain, gain insight: what was really going on, what sense can you make of the situation, can you integrate theory into the experience/situation, can you demonstrate an improved awareness and self-development because of the situation (max 100 words).

4. Conclusions: what can be concluded in a general and specific sense from this situation/experience and the analyses you have undertaken, what are you going to do differently in this type of situation next time, what steps are you going to take based on what you have learned (max 100 words).
